Working together, teachers, parents and pupils decided that they would achieve an A rating for energy consumption, by changing the way everyone used energy in the school


Technical and financial support was needed, so

Success builds success!


Through the habitual undertaking of seemingly insignificant actions by all members of the school, the 9th Primary School was able to achieve an outstanding A Display rating for energy
